Singtel Waterfront Theatre (SWT)



- This is the Singtel Waterfront Theatre.
- I am going to the Singtel Waterfront Theatre to watch a *National Theatre Live* screening.
- A *National Theatre Live* screening is like watching a movie. There will be a screen set up on stage.

Assistive Listening



- Assistive listening system is available for this venue.
- Hearing aid users with a Telecoil-enabled programme can benefit from the system provided.
- Please arrive at the venue 30 min before the performance.
- Please approach an usher at the venue and they can assist with the setup.

Moving about



- There are many seats in the Singtel Waterfront Theatre.
- When I buy a ticket to watch a screening, the seat number is indicated on my ticket.
- I will find my seat in the Singtel Waterfront Theatre using my ticket. An usher may also assist me.

Moving about



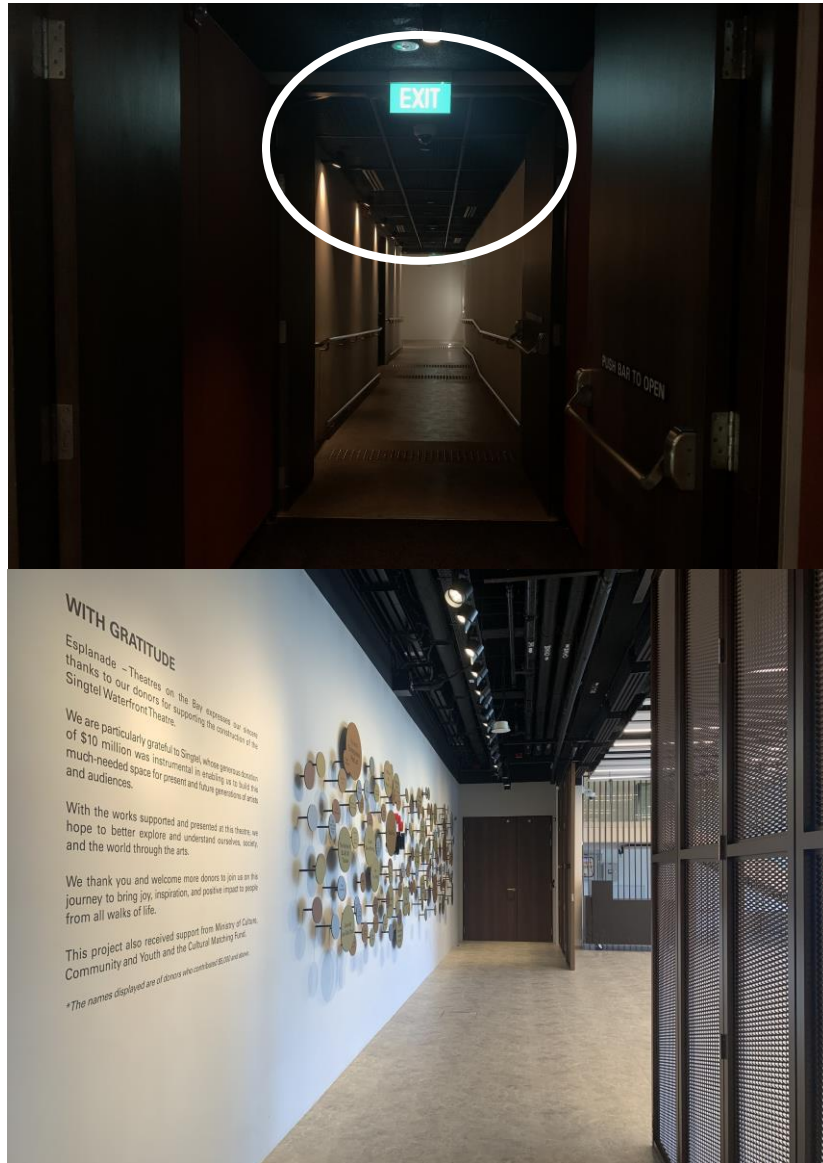
- If I want to move or dance **on the spot** during the screening, that is alright.
- If I need to use the washroom during the performance, that is alright. An usher can show me the way to the washroom located outside the venue. After using the washroom, I can ask an usher to show me back to my seat.

Calm Space

- Sometimes, I want to leave my seat when the screening is happening and look for a place to calm down. I can do that.
- I can go back to my seat in the Singtel Waterfront Theatre any time during the screening when I am ready.
- A Calm Space at the Singtel Waterfront Theatre is located on Level 2, at the foyer.



Directions to the Calm Space at Singtel Waterfront Theatre



- If I am seated at Level 1, I can exit through either Door 1 or Door 2 located at the sides.
- I know I have exited the theatre when I see a wall with circle shapes. This is a sponsorship wall thanking those who have contributed to the building of this theatre.

Directions to the Calm Space at Singtel Waterfront Theatre



- When I am at the foyer space of the Singtel Waterfront Theatre at Level 1, I can choose to take the staircase or the lift up to Level 2.
- If I need help, I can ask an usher to show me the way to the Calm Space.

Directions to the Calm Space at Singtel Waterfront Theatre



- If I take the stairs to Level 2, I should turn right when I reach the end of the stairs. The Calm Space will be on the right of the Door 4.

Directions to the Calm Space at Singtel Waterfront Theatre



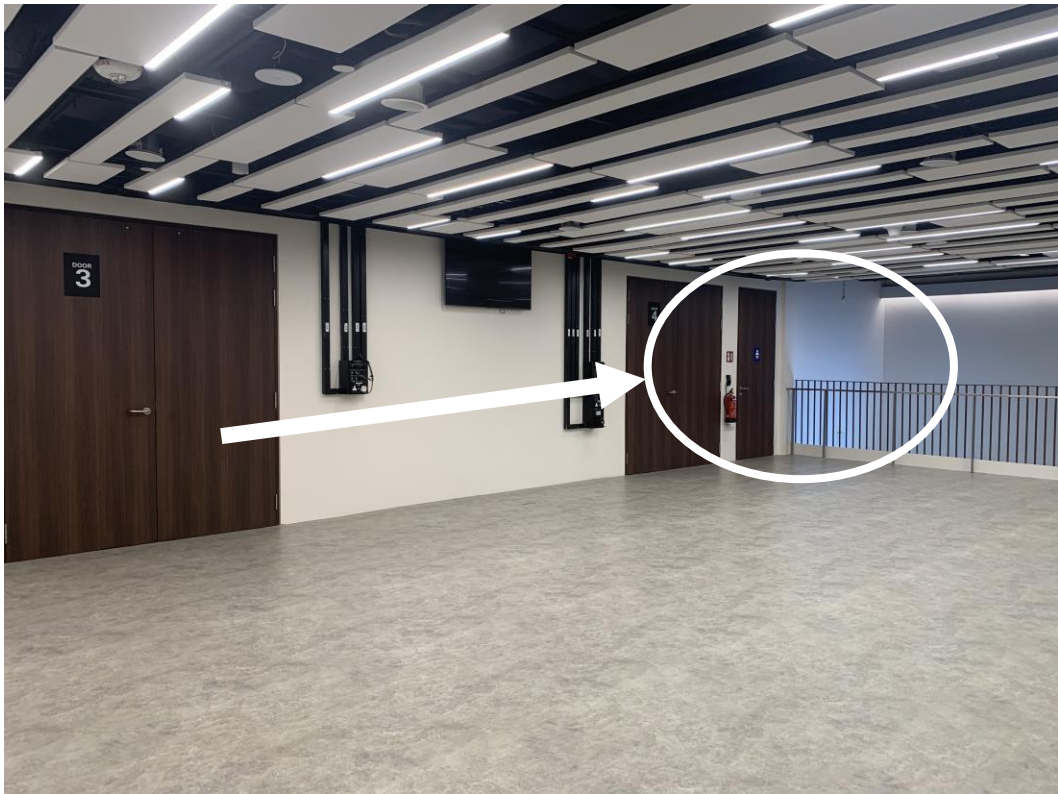
- If I take the lift to Level 2, the Calm Space will be located just straight ahead when I exit.

Directions to the Calm Space at Singtel Waterfront Theatre



- If I am seated at Level 2, I can exit through either Door 3 or Door 4 located at the back.
- If I need help, I can ask an usher to show me the way to the Calm Space.

Directions to the Calm Space at Singtel Waterfront Theatre



- When I come out of the venue from Level 2, the Calm Room will be on the right.
- If I need help, I can ask an usher to show me the way to the Calm Space.

Directions to the Calm Space at Singtel Waterfront Theatre



- This is where the Calm Space is located beside Door 4.
- There will be chairs for me to rest on.
- Whenever I am ready, I can inform the usher that I would like to head back into the theatre to enjoy the rest of the screening.

- The cast is made up of actors.
- During the screening, I will see the actors perform different characters.
