In this new performance, I wanted to immerse myself in the most emotional aspect, something that is achieved by weaving everything together seamlessly—dance, music, and dramaturgy. Every detail has been carefully crafted.

Vuela is also a celebration of the 25th anniversary of my private company, a milestone that has not been easy to achieve. We have reached this point because we've worked tirelessly over the years, as this is a privately funded company. From the very beginning, we have sustained ourselves thanks to the audience, to whom I can never express enough gratitude for their support. Without you, I could not continue dreaming. We have created 13 productions, performed more than 4,000 shows, and traveled across half the world—including several times in Singapore—always without letting our guard down!

Although it has been a long journey, it is incredibly moving to look back and see that I have established my own distinctive mark. It is also deeply satisfying to know that all these years have allowed me to help others by using my image and influence to promote charitable projects. But despite these 25 years, I feel there is still so much more to do. Let's keep moving!




