

## Storytelling with Shadow Tubes!

The stories of Sang Kancil have been passed down for generations through different ways such as oral storytelling and shadow puppetry.

Make your own shadow tubes to re-enact or create new stories about Sang Kancil and his many adventures.

### What you need:



Cardboard tubes  
(kitchen towel rolls)



Paint and brushes



Printer



Scissors and penknife



Clingwrap or  
any clear plastic



Rubber bands



Double-sided tape



Torchlight or  
mobile phone

## Instructions:



1. Paint the cardboard roll. Let it dry.




2. Print and cut out the silhouettes provided on the next page.



3. Stick double-sided tape onto the back of the silhouette cut-outs.



4. Cut out a rectangular piece of plastic or clingwrap. Check that it is big enough to wrap around the top of the cardboard roll and around the sides.



5. Stick the cut-out (one per clingwrap) to the middle of the clingwrap/ clear plastic.




6. Then, wrap one end of the cardboard roll with the clingwrap/ clear plastic. Make sure that the cut-out is in the middle and the plastic is as smooth as possible. Use rubber bands to secure the clingwrap/plastic in place. Make as many as you need.




7. Turn off the lights and shine the torchlight through the other end of the cardboard roll.

How did the rest of the animals get out of the well? Did Sang Harimau get his revenge? Project the shadow onto a wall and create your own stories of Sang Kancil. Get your friends and family involved!


Use these cut-outs to re-enact the many stories of Sang Kancil and the animals in the forest.




